

Summer Camp in South Barrington

Welcome, campers, to an exciting and fun new session of Summer Camp at the South Barrington Park District!
The Camp Counselors are extremely excited, and can't wait to provide all campers with a truly wonderful camp experience.

What to Bring:

Campers should bring the following each day (please label all items):

Lunch in an insulated container with an icepack
Water bottle
Sunscreen
Towel
Sunscreen
Swimsuit
Gym Shoes
Afternoon Snack
Camp T-shirt for **all Field Trip Days** (One shirt is provided for each camper. Replacement T-shirts are available for \$10)

Camper Notes

Campers **must wear GYM SHOES** in order to attend camp. Sandals are not permitted.
Electronic games are not allowed at camp.
We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items.

Schedule:

Camp Hours: 7:00am- 9:00am Extended AM Care
 9:00am- 4:00pm Summer Camp Hours
 4:00pm- 6:00pm Extended PM Care

Open swim is held on Monday, Wednesday, Friday. Pick up on open swim will be at the South Barrington PK. Dist.
Camp shirts **must** be worn on all field trip days. Please see camp schedule at your location for more information.

Drop off and Pick up:

Before Camp Care: Please walk your camper to the extended program located on the lower level of the South Barrington Community Center, 3 Tennis Club Lane. All campers must be signed by an adult each day.

Campers must arrive no later than 8:30 am for transportation to their camp sites.

Summer Camp: **Summer Camp begins at 9:00 am.** All campers must be signed in at their camp site. For the safety of all children in our care, campers cannot be dropped off before 9:00am. Counselors who are at their camp sites are busy preparing for the day, and cannot assume responsibility for supervising campers until camp begins at 9:00am.

Summer camp ends at 4:00pm for those children not enrolled in after camp care. All campers must be signed out by an adult.

Late fees in the amount of \$1 per minute will apply beginning promptly at 4:00pm.

Kiss and Fly Drop off Option: (At Dunteman Park location only) For your convenience, a camp counselor will be at the Dunteman location from 9:00am-9:15am, so you can kiss your child goodbye, and get on with your day, without having to get out of your vehicle. For late arrivals, after 9:15am, campers will need to be escorted directly to their camp location.

(Please note: Kiss and Fly will not be available on the first day of each session.)

After Camp Care: Campers must be picked up no later than 6:00pm at the South Barrington Community Center, 3 Tennis Club Lane. All campers must be signed out by an adult. Late fees in the amount of \$1 per minute will apply beginning promptly at 6:00pm.

Paperwork:

A Camper information form and camp code of conduct form must be filled out prior to leaving your camper on the first day of camp. Forms can be obtained at the camp sites, or can be downloaded in advance at sbpd.net.

Code of Conduct

The goal of the South Barrington Park District is to provide an atmosphere for children to develop a variety of skills and relationships while enjoying healthy activities. Throughout the summer, we will reinforce respect, responsibility, caring and honesty among campers. As a family, please read, discuss and initial this Code of Conduct together.

Code of Conduct	Initials
<p><u>Appropriate Conversation and Language</u> Children will not be allowed to discuss inappropriate topics or contribute to demeaning conversations about other campers or staff. Children will refrain from using obscene language or gestures for any reason.</p>	
<p><u>Respect</u> Children need to follow directions the first time that they are given. This is for the safety of all campers. Please treat fellow campers and staff with respect. It is also important to use and care for the equipment, toys and games properly so other campers can enjoy them. We will care for the property of the South Barrington Park District, of other campers and of the camp staff.</p>	
<p><u>Responsibility</u> All children need to remain with their group and within eyesight of their counselor. This applies while we are on the South Barrington Park District grounds and offsite field trips. We want all campers to be safe at all times.</p>	
<p><u>Play</u> Campers are asked not to engage in any horseplay with each other or with another counselor. No one will be allowed to hit, kick, push or display any type of aggressive behavior. We will use appropriate words to settle our differences and keep our hands and feet to ourselves.</p>	

What will happen when a code is violated:

If an incident occurs where a child conducts himself/herself in a manner that jeopardizes their safety, the safety of others, or is not in accordance with the mission of the South Barrington Park District Camp, the following steps will be taken:

First Violation

A staff member will address and document the issued directly to the child, the child may be removed from an activity. The parent or guardian will be contacted during the day or at the end of day, depending on the incident.

Second Violation

A staff member will address and document the issue directly with the child. The parent or guardian will be contacted. **Parent or guardian must sign the incident report at the time of picking up their child.**

Third Violation

A staff member will address and document the issue directly with the child. The parent or guardian will be contact immediately to pick their child up from camp. The child will be suspended from camp. **Parent or guardian must sign the incident report at the time of picking up their child.**

Fourth Violation

Child will be dismissed from camp for the remainder of the program. A staff member will address and document the issue directly with the child. The parent or guardian will be contacted immediately to pick their child up from camp. **Parent or guardian must sign the incident report at the time of pick-up.**

****Any child causing severe harm or threat to another child or staff member will be dismissed from camp immediately. No credits will be given for suspension or dismissal.***
